## Nagano Campus - School Forum-

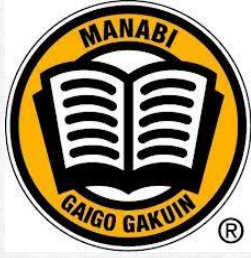
Indonesian students introduced their country's cuisine, music and games to junior high school students at Ueda City Daini Junior High School as a lecturer of "International Exchange".
