As art and design are expanding their sphere of activity in society, art universities are seeking a wider range of human resources, and the criteria for entrance examinations are beginning to place more emphasis on criteria other than technical skill. Since its establishment, TORIN SCHOOL OF ARTS & DESIGN has been constantly searching for ways to effectively prepare students for the entrance examinations within the limited time available. As a result, for the past several years, our acceptance rate to art universities has been the highest in Japan.



Comprehensive Course

Through sketching, students will learn basic expressive skills and the characteristics of Japanese expression. This course is recommended for students aiming for vocational schools or those with limited experience in art. 10 hours per week will be devoted to the completion of one work of art. At the end of the course, students will be critiqued in class and their work will be explained in Japanese.



Famous University Preparatory Course

This course is dedicated to art classes with the goal of gaining admission to a prestigious university. Students can practice for interviews, receive guidance on essays, and prepare for practical examinations.

Students receive 200 hours of practical skills instruction per semester for 6 months, and classes are offered even on days when there are no Japanese language classes, allowing students to concentrate on art.



Graduate School Preparatory Course

This course is designed to help students practice interviewing and receive guidance on creating their own portfolios in order to be accepted into graduate school. You will receive two days a week, two hours a day of solid instruction.










