





Specified Skills Japan Employment Program

Students will study at a Japanese language school (maximum 24 months) to raise their Japanese language level while passing the examination which is a requirement for obtaining a Specified Skills Worker Visa.

This program also allows students to pass employment exams while still in school and start work immediately after graduation. The Specified Skills Worker Visa allows you to work in Japan for up to 5 years. If you work in the nursing care field for at least 3 years during the period and obtain a care worker qualification, you can move to the "Nursing Care" visa status.



Program participation conditions

In addition to the admission requirements listed in the application guidelines, the following conditions are required.

- ① Those seeking employment in Japan on a Specified Skills Worker Visa
- ② Those who are seeking employment through an introduction by MANABI Language Institute (YCC·JAPAN Co., Ltd.)

Scholarship Eligibility Conditions

- ① Those who have paid the tuition fee for one year in a lump sum at the time of admission
- ② Those who have passed JLPT-N4 or equivalent at the time of application interview. or

Those who have passed the JLPT-N5 or its equivalent at the time of the application interview, and who have passed JLPT-N4 level test by the designated date before the issuance of the Certificate of Eligibility.
