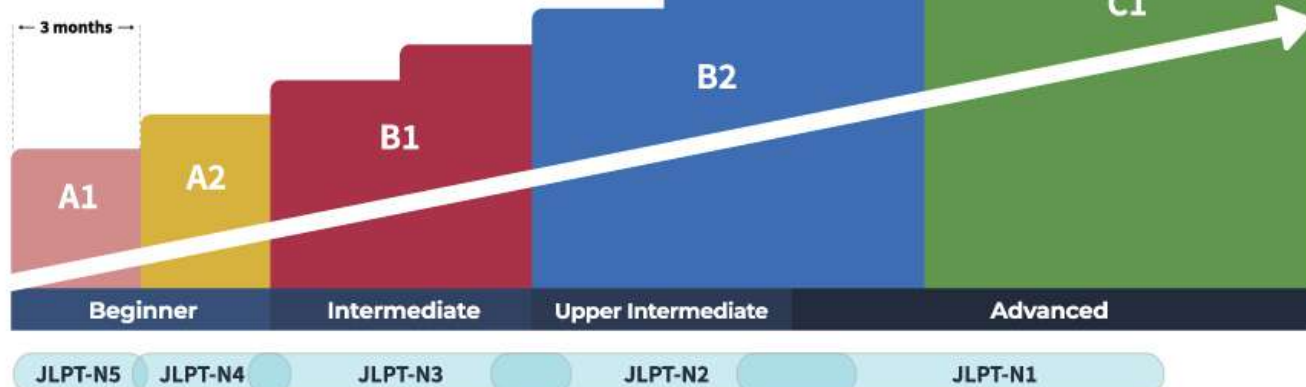

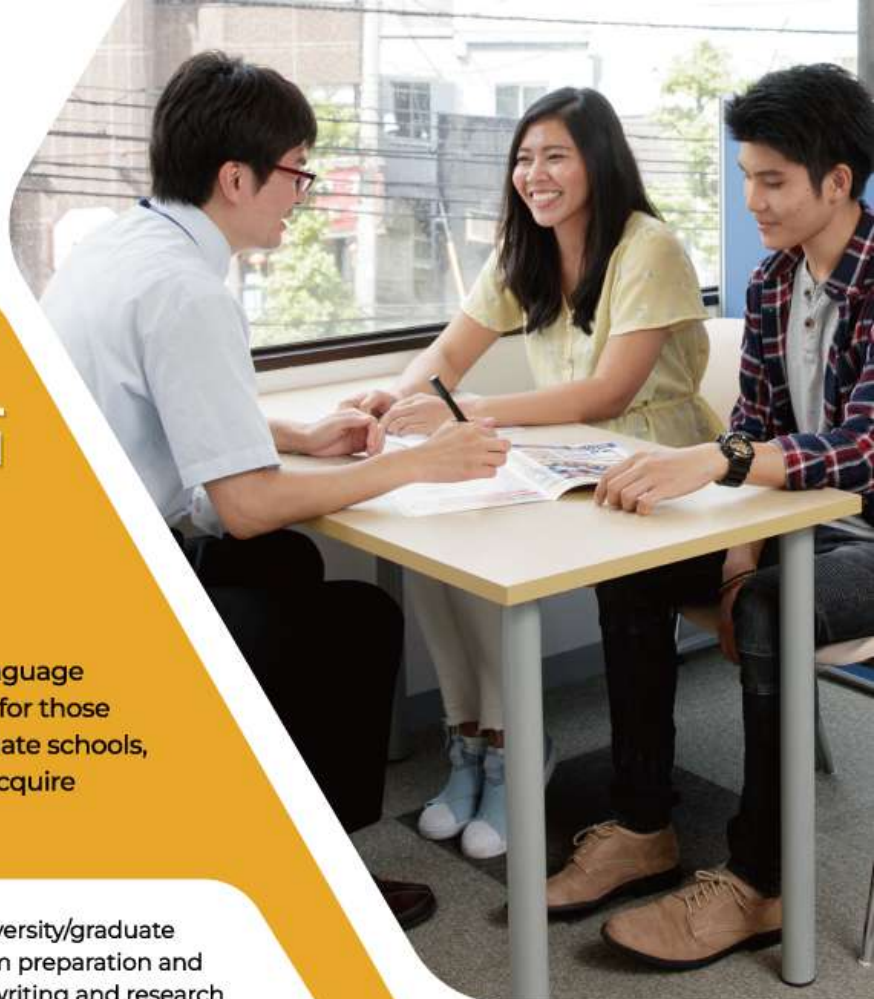

The curriculum includes everything from finding a university/graduate school that matches your preferences to entrance exam preparation and admission procedures. We particularly focus on essay writing and research proposal creation, which are important for Japanese entrance exams, and interview practice, providing excellent guidance.

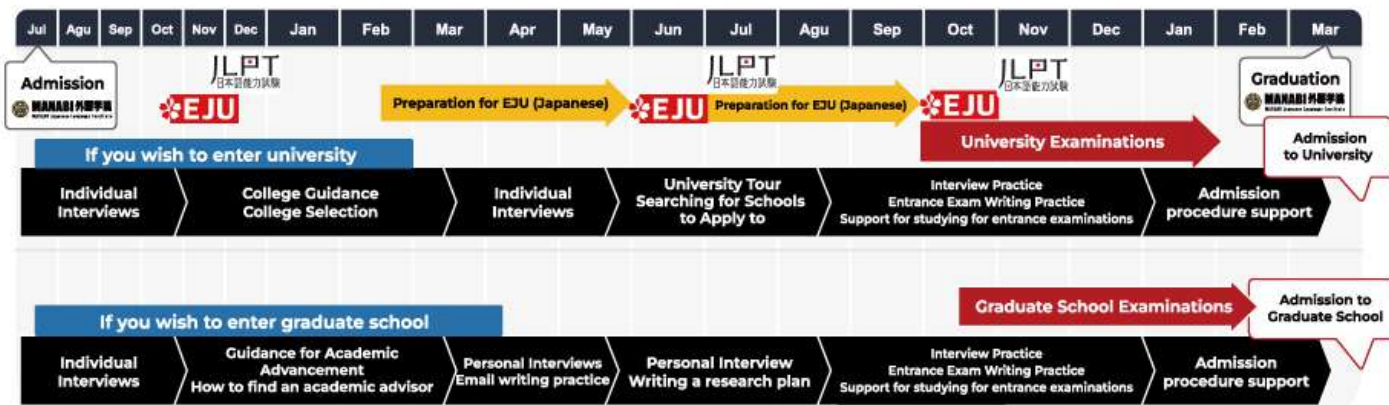
