Dec. 2005	MANABI Japanese Language Institute Tokyo Campus opened.
Oct. 2009	Student capacity increased to 240.
Apr. 2010	Relocated the campus from Kinshicho to Kamezawa, Sumida.
June 2010	Student capacity increased to 340.
Apr. 2013	Student capacity increased to 400.
Oct. 2014	Student capacity increased to 480.
Oct. 2015	Relocated the campus from Kamezawa, Sumida-ku to Ryogoku, and increased student capacity to 600.
Apr. 2017	Student capacity increased to 720.
Oct. 2018	Listed in "Student Visa Notification Annex Table 1," complying with the Ministry of Justice's new standards for Japanese language educational institutions.
Oct. 2024	Certified as a "Properly Managing School (Class 1)" by the Immigration Services Agency.
